

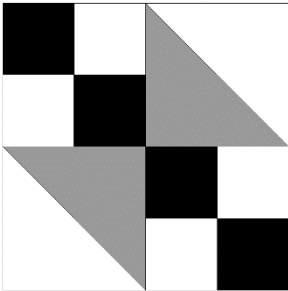

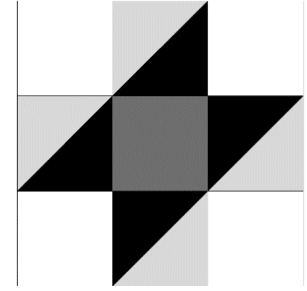
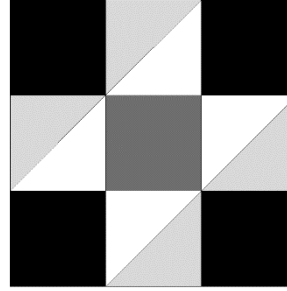

6' x 6" (6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished)

November Block 1



November Block 2



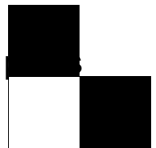
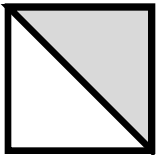
These 2 very easy blocks are designed using half-square triangles and squares.

Each block finishes at 6.5" x 6.5" . These will make very nice filler blocks at the end so you can make multiples if you wish.

Below you will find the number of units for each section.

November Block 1

Cut fabric 1 square and fabric 2 square @ 3 7/8" x 3 7/8". Make 2 units as described last month.

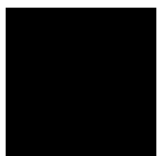


Cut fabric 1 and fabric 3 into 2" x 8" strips. Join the 2 strips with a 1/4" seam and to the darker fabric. Sub-cut into 2" units. Follow the diagram to join 2 units to make each Four patch block. Make 2 units

Join the 4 square units and the HS triangle units to make the block.

It should be 6.6" x 6.5" when you are done.

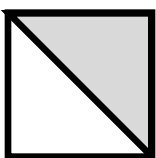
November Block 2



Cut fabric 2.5" x 2.5". Make 4.



Cut fabric 2.5" x 2.5". Make 1.



Cut fabric 2 7/8" x 2.7/8". Make 4 units.
