CLASS DESCRIPTION AND SUPPLY LIST

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DESCRIPTION:

Create a fun and curvaceous quilt using one of the instructor's small patterns: 1) a bold and funky Femme Fatale, or 2) a more serene abstract landscape. While creating this small piece, you will learn all about the flip and sew technique for creating curves built on a foundation of muslin. Great for using up those leftover strips and scraps.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Light-weight piece of muslin (fat quarter size)
- Black fine-tipped permanent marker (i.e. pigma micron marker – size 05) available at quilt shops or Michaels
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Fabric scissors
- Sewing machine
- ¼" piecing foot
- Thread for piecing
- Straight pins
- Strips and scraps of fabric.

Please choose one of the following projects and bring the fabrics listed below it.

Project I: Bold and Funky

Scraps and strips in the following colours

- Black and white prints
- A variety of bright colours. Include some bold prints, mottled fabrics, batiks, etc.

Project II: Abstract Ocean Waves

Scraps and strips in the following colours:

- dark blues
- medium and light blues
- turquoise
- medium and dark greens

We can pool our strips and scraps to provide more options for all.
