


Strip of the Month (SOM) Program for 2019-2020

Strip Three A - 4 Colour Peaks



This 4 colour strip of various widths will be cut into angled strips and sewn back together to resemble mountains. Finished Size @ 40 - 42 inches wide by 8 - 9 inches deep. All seams 1/4 inch.

Cutting Chart

- Fabric A(which will be at the top of the strip)Cut two 5 inch strips by WOF (Width of Fabric)Fabric B(a contrast strip)Cut two 7/8 inch strips by WOFFabric C(a contrast strip)Cut two 7/8 inch strips by WOF
- Fabric C (a second contrast strip. If fabric B is light, make fabric C dark) Cut two 1 1/4 inch strips by WOF
- Fabric D (which will be at the bottom of the strip) Cut two 5 inch strips by WOF

Sewing and Slicing Instructions





- 1. Using one of each of the 4 coloured fabric strips, stitch together to create one larger strip set. Sew in an offset manner (see diagram 1 at left) creating **Strip Set 1**. Press seams towards Fabric A.
- 2. Using the rest of the 4 coloured fabric strips, offset in the other direction and stitch together to create a mirror image of the first strip set (see diagram 2 at left) creating **Strip Set 2**. Press seams toward Fabric D.
- 3 a). Using a ruler with a 45 degree angle line, slice **Strip Set 1** into the following widths. See diagram 3 at left. **Hint: Label Segments A-F.**
 - (A) 2 3/4 inch (B) 2 3 /4 inch (C) 4 inch (D) 4 7/8 inch (E) 3 inch (F) 4 3/8 inch
- 3 b). Using a ruler with a 45 degree angle line, slice Strip Set 2 into the following widths. See diagram 3 Hint: Label Segments A-F.
 - (A) 4 3/8 inch (B) 2 3/4 inch (C) 3 inch (D) 3 1/2 inch (E) 3 7/8 inch (F) 4 3/4 inch

Finishing

- 4. Stitch together A segments matching seams at the contrast strips. Repeat for segments B, C, D, E and F. Join in sequence A F to create the wide strip. Hint: If you have fabric left from steps 2 and 3, you can slice more segments and make your finished strip wider.
- 5. Trim the edges to create your finished strip. See lines in diagram below.
