

## Strip of the Month (SOM) Program for 2019-2020 Strips Four (Dec 2019) 2 Filler Strips

## Filler Strip A- Checkerboard

This filler strip of contrasting colours is easy and finishes about 42 inches wide x 5 inches deep(before optional finishing strip is added) All seams $1 / 4$ inch (finished width dependant on your WOF) Cut two pieces 2.75" x WOF (Width of Fabric) in each colour. Sew together two sets as below:


Reverse every second segment and re-assemble to form an alternating band for checkerboard effect.


Finishing strip on top and bottom is optional. Cut at 1.75 inches $x$ WOF.


## Filler Strip B - Alternating

This two coloured strip consists of 3 strips of fabric that will be sewn together, then sliced. The segments are rotated and re-assembled to form a simple alternating pattern. Finished width @ 42 inches by 5.5 inches deep.

## Cutting Chart

Strips A and C are made using the same fabric, and Strip B is a contrast fabric
Strip A: $31 / 4$ inches x WOF (Width of Fabric)
Strip C: (using same fabric as strip A) $21 / 2$ inches x WOF
Strip B: (contrasting colour) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch x WOF

## Sewing and Slicing Instructions

1. Sew strips together in alphabetical sequence: $A+B+C$.
 Press away from centre strip.
2. Cut into 5 inch segments
3. Reverse every second segment, match interlocking seams and sew back together

## Finishing

Additional edge strips will be sewn onto this filler strip, but suggest you wait until the final assembly to decide colour and size of the edge strips.
