
Searching Pinterest and other sites will bring you lots of ideas on what to do with your left over bindings. Here are some obvious ideas...

Just press them open, and now you have jelly roll strips that you can use in a jelly roll or scrap quilt.



Use them as a tie for gift packages, or the quilt you are about to give away.





You can insert the bindings into fabric strips to create a pleated look.



You can join random smaller pieces of binding together to create a multi coloured binding for your quilt piece.







For my challenge I inserted my left over gold binding as pleats, and then sewed them down in different directions



My Finished Challenge:

A three dimensional wall hanging, on point. Of course, I used up my gold binding in the pleats so had to make more binding to finish the piece.



Not sure if you want to join our challenge of the month and create pieces like this that you have no idea what to do with?

- 1. Use 100% Cotton Batting and make some pot holders or table hot pads
- 2. Create a pillow cover or small wall hanging
- 3. Save for the Toonie Treasures Our Guild does plan to hold a quilt show in 2024.
