Some suggestions for gift and/or décor items for Christmas:

- Place mats or Table Runners
- Mug Rug for Santa or Coasters
- Tree skirt or Stockings
- Tree/gift scarf (see photo)
- Gift/wine bags and Goodie bags for Santa to take home for the elves
- Pillow tops and Door decorations – Noel, etc
- Table decoration/place mat for our December Social

There are many different ways to put words on your project. Some of the more common methods are:

- Quick Fuse: using fusibles and/or glue sticks. (If using fusibles, remember to reverse your letters when planning your project).
- Thread painting: review Mary Kay Hopkins video on our website.
- Use fabric with words already printed on it or make your own!
