Last month we introduced our Challenge topic for 2023/24. Your mission is to produce a piece that represents or illustrates a well-known saying or proverb.

## Examples are:

- -Up the creek without a paddle
- -under the weather
- -I'm all ears
- -a stitch in time saves nine
- -lame duck
- -seeing eye to eye



The possibilities are endless. Brainstorm with your partner or a friend, or google favourite sayings or proverbs for more ideas. Jot down any ideas that interest you, and keep them in the back of your mind as you look at fabrics, quilt blocks, art, photographs, etc.

**The rules** are simple: Your piece must be less than 140 inches in perimeter, must have layers, and some quilting. It can be a wall-hanging, a bag, a cushion, a stuffed critter, a tea cosy... whatever you want to make.

We plan to display these items at our quilt show in June and, as we have in the past, have a quiz for visitors to try to match your saying with your piece.
