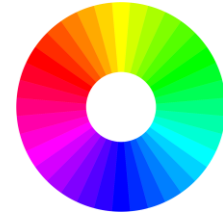


Develop Your Quilty Sense of Colour

Skill level: All levels.

Students will learn the following:

Workstations for online class:

- Ironing station with board and iron, etc.
- Sewing tools like scissors, pins, hera marker, snips, etc.

Fabric Requirements for Class:

- *You will be pulling out a selection as you go.*
- *If you like, you can prepare by pulling out some of your favourites and some of your “problems”.*

Project:

- *You will make a sampler with four patches to help you represent what you have learnt.*
