Lorrie will be here to help you with your chosen pattern, ideas, and fabric choices. With a small class setting, all of the participants will be able to help each other and offer ideas if needed.

How to Prepare for the Panel Mania Workshop



- Go online and look for ideas to use your panel. Then find some coordinating fabrics in your stash. Design and then cut the panel and fabrics to create a wall hanging or small quilt, baby quilt or table runner ~ anything you can imagine.
- Fabric lines often sell patterns and coordinating fabrics to go with their panels (Northcott is one).
- If you are unsure where to start, bring your panel, some coordinating fabric and some ideas and Lorrie will help you brainstorm. Or you can contact her ahead of time to schedule a Zoom consult.
- If you already have a panel and pattern chosen, go ahead and precut so you can be sewing right away.
- Take a photo of the panel before your start any modifications. It will be fun to compare the before and after for Show and Tell.
- Bring your sewing machine and your basic supplies. Most of us will be sewing at some point. We will supply a cutting board, ruler and rotary cutter, iron and ironing board.

Note: This is not a sewing lesson. It is a Hands-On Workshop focusing on design and creativity to create something fun!
